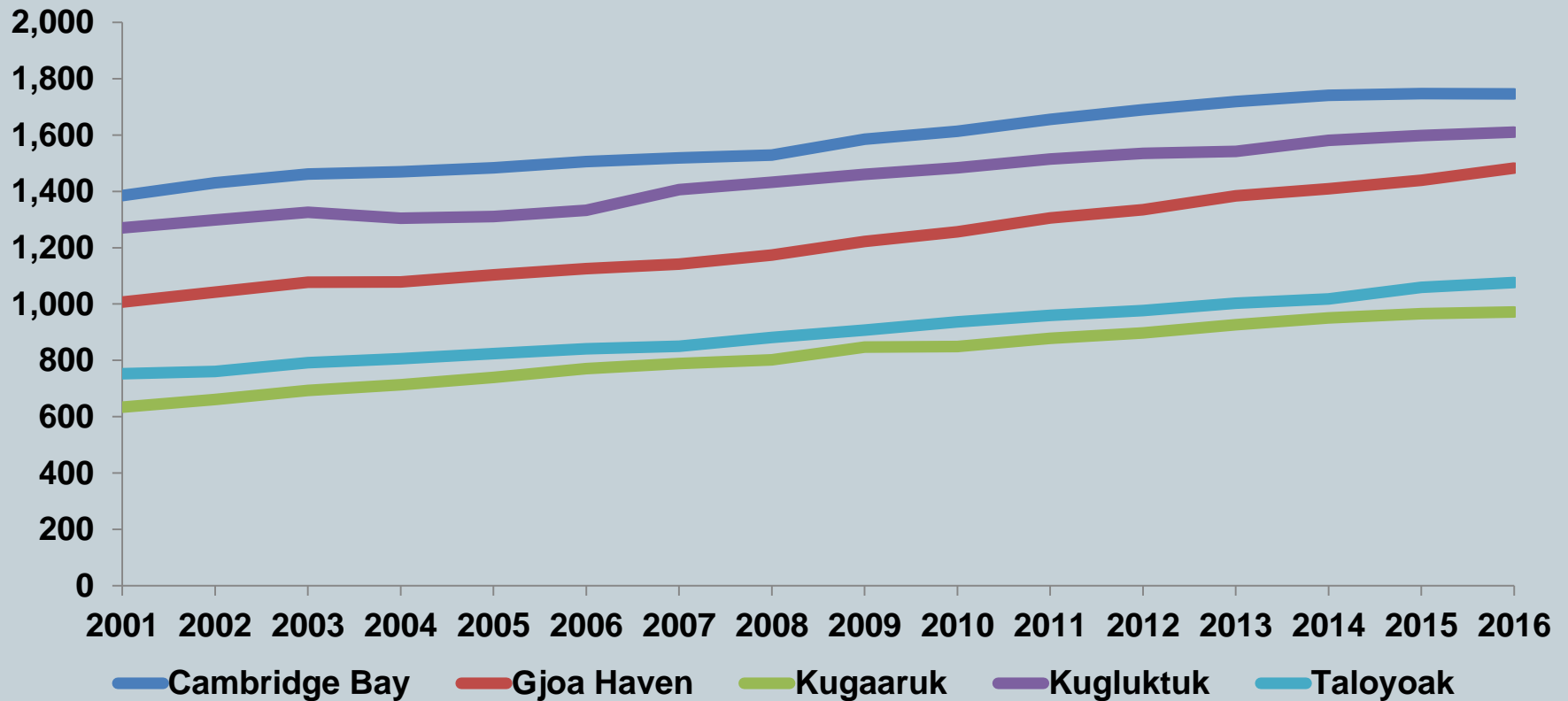

Population Estimates 2001-2016

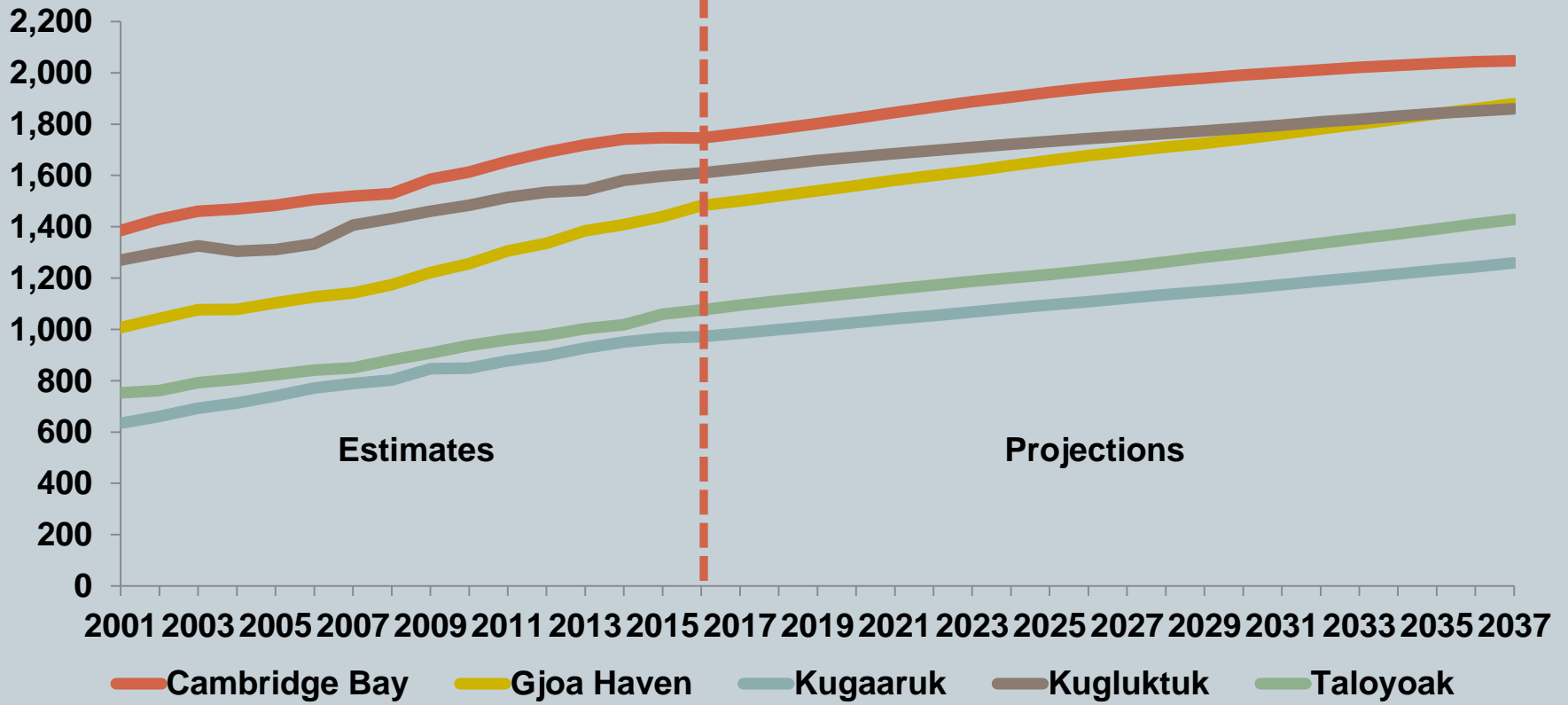

Population Projections 2001-2037

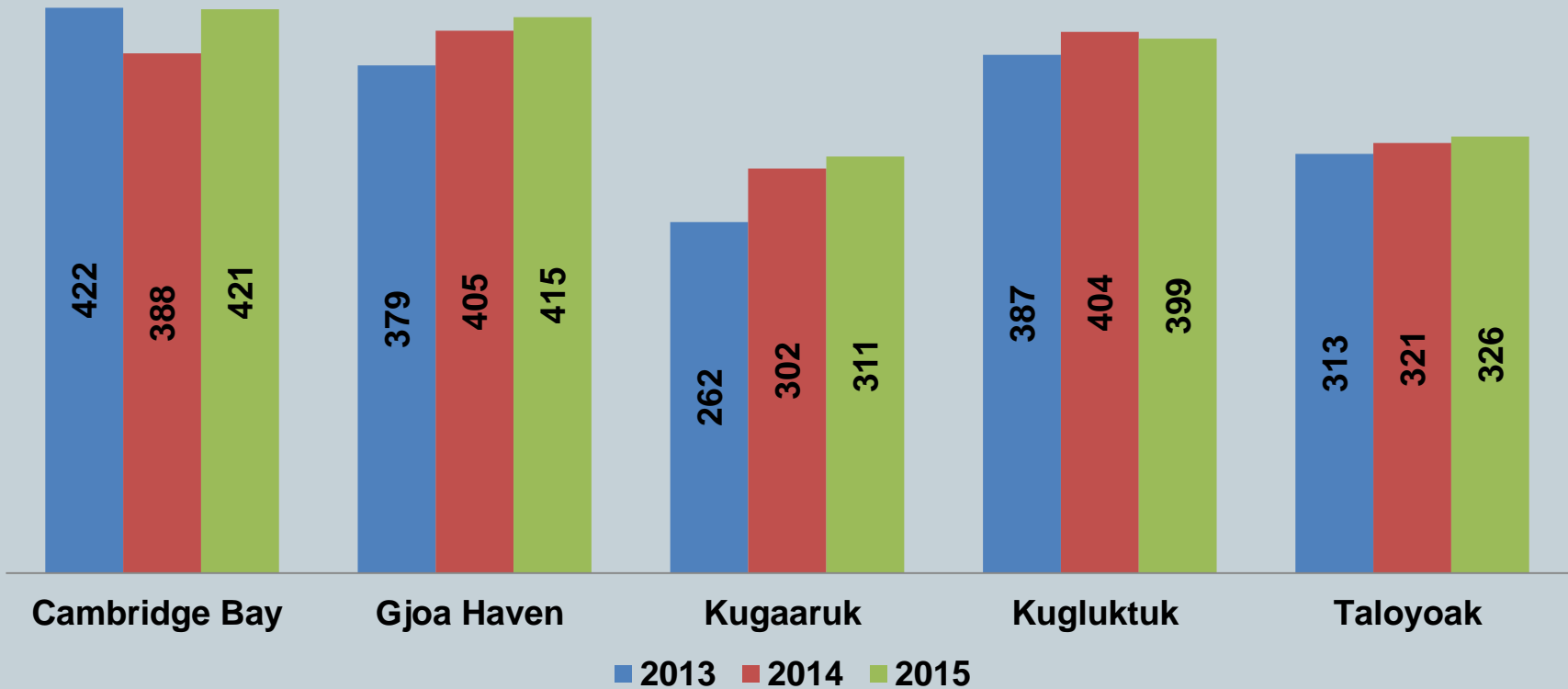

Public School Enrolment 2013-2015



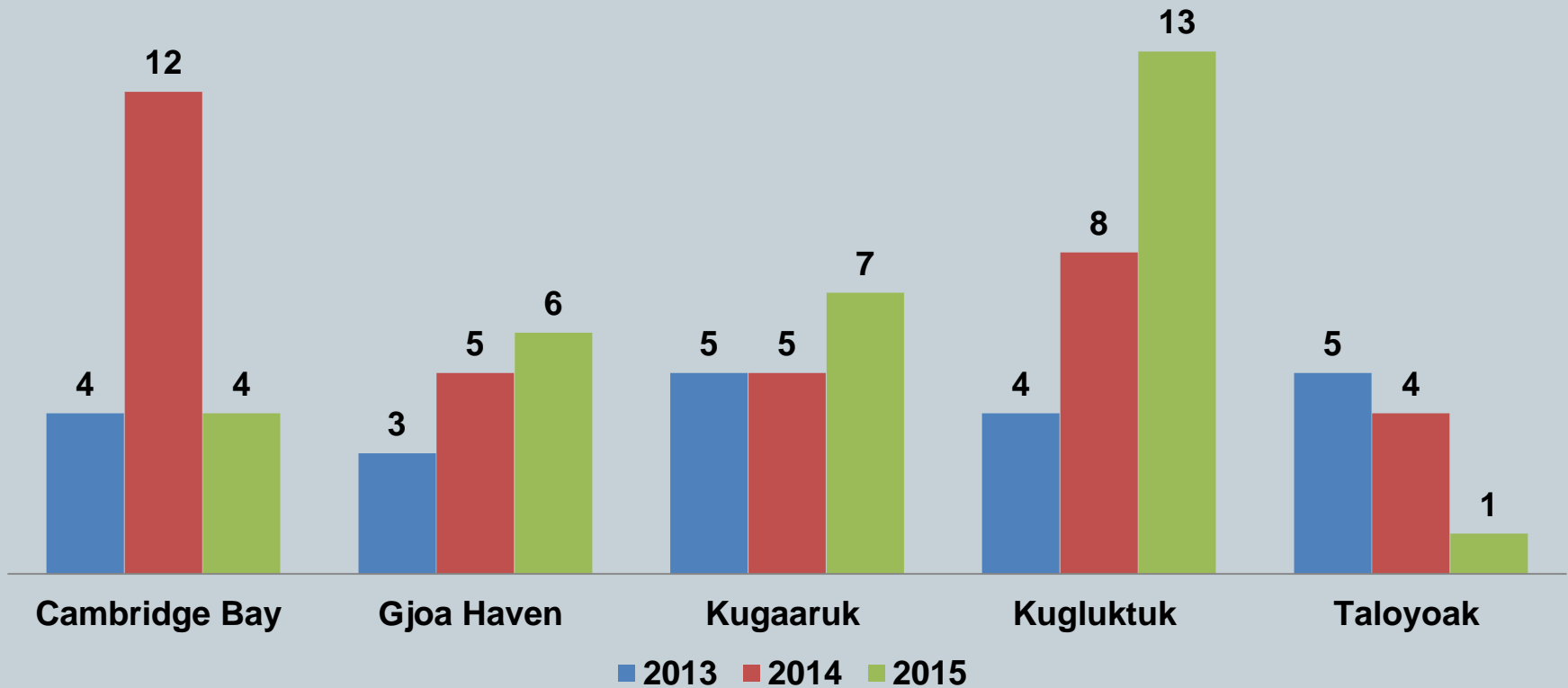

Number of Graduates 2013-2015



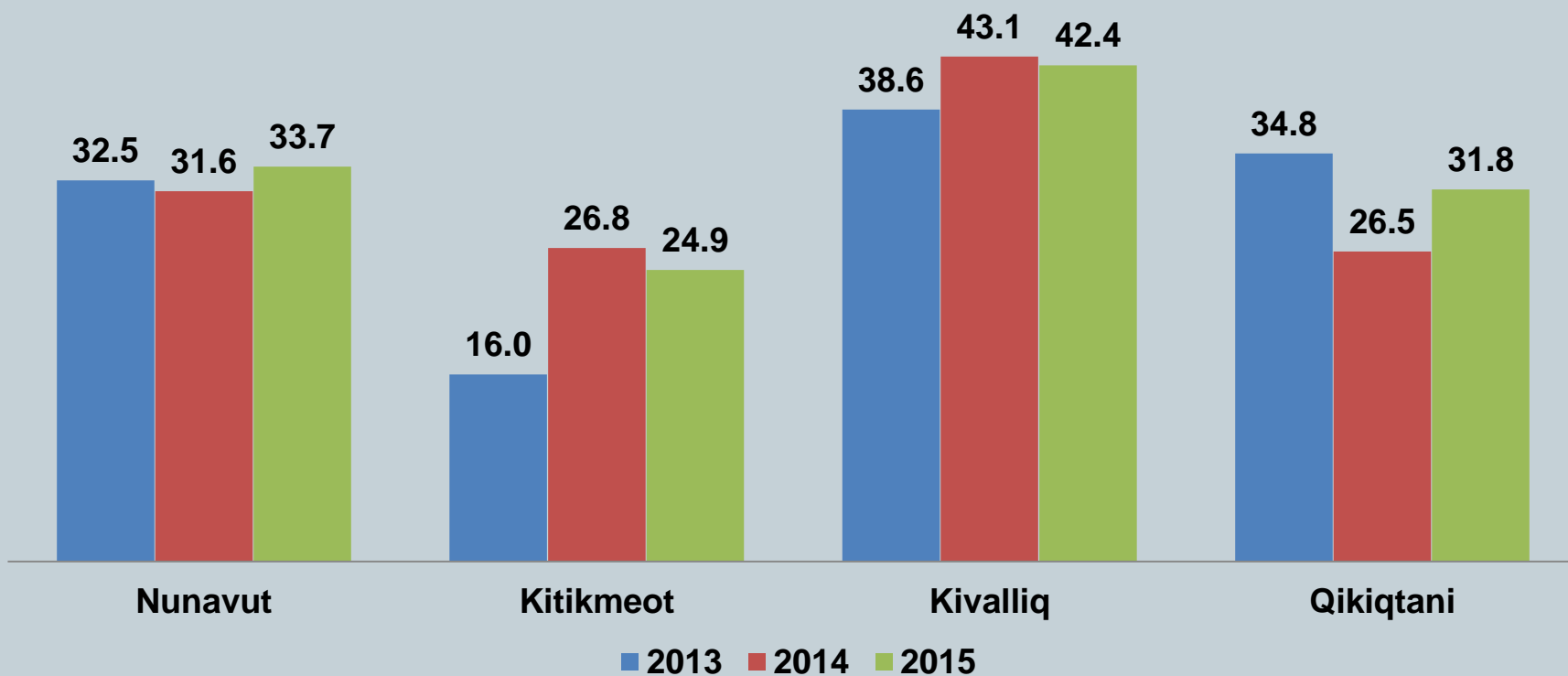

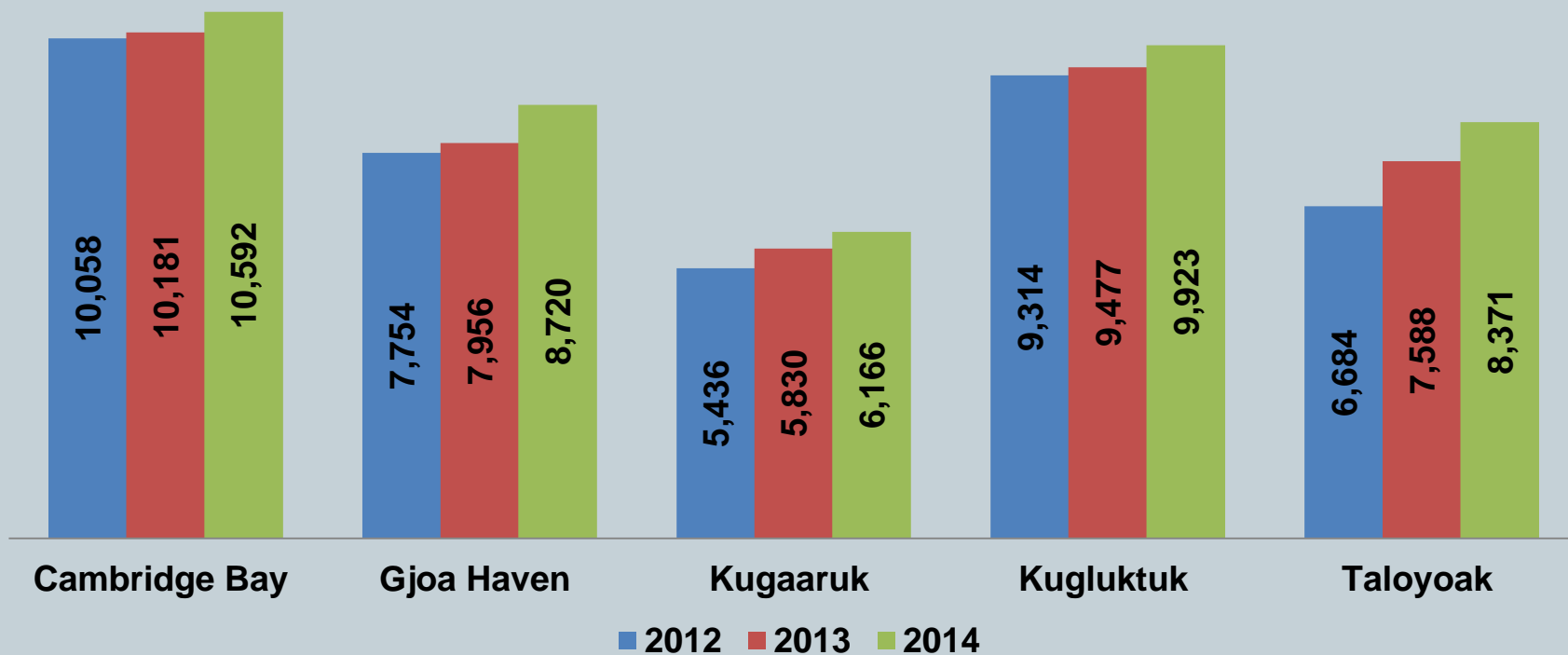
Graduation Rates (%) 2013-2015

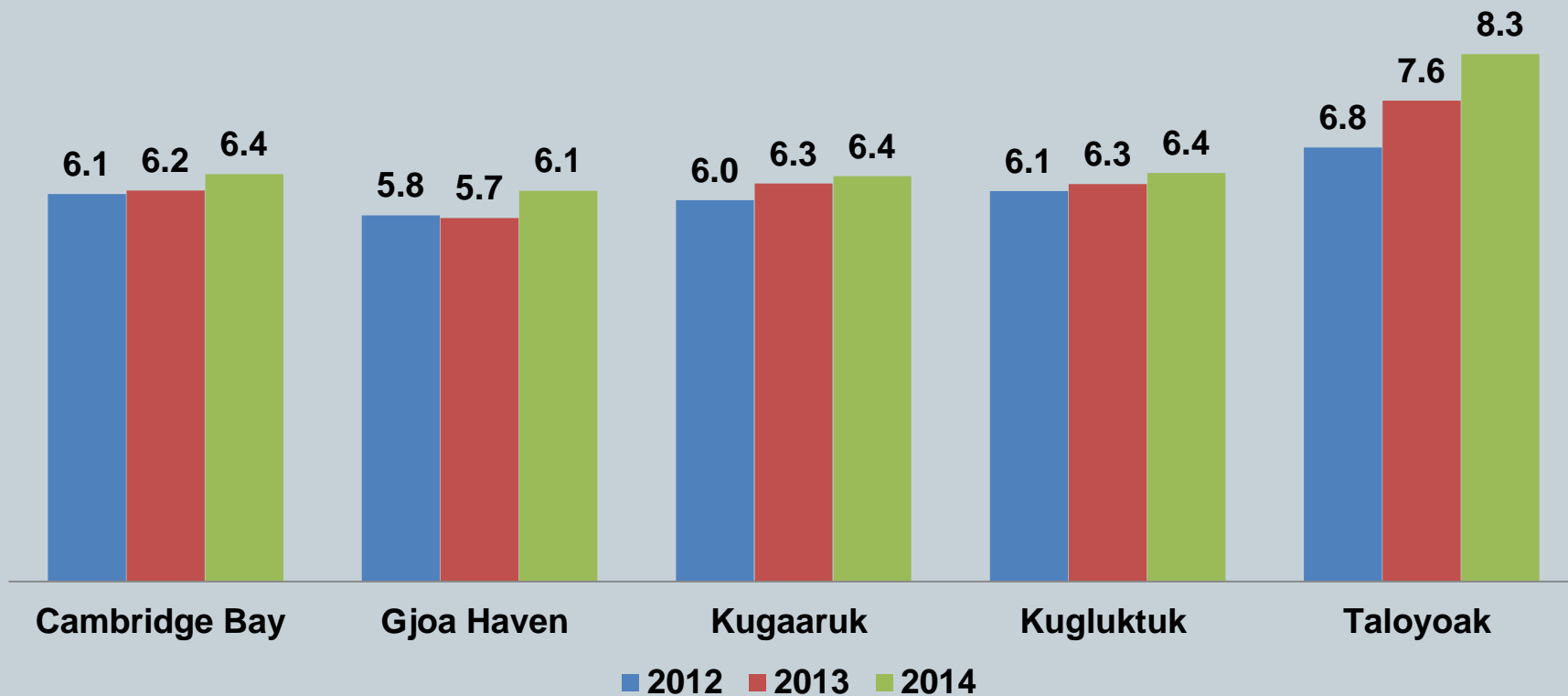
Community Health Centre Visits 2012-2014

Per Capita Community Health Centre Visits 2012-2014



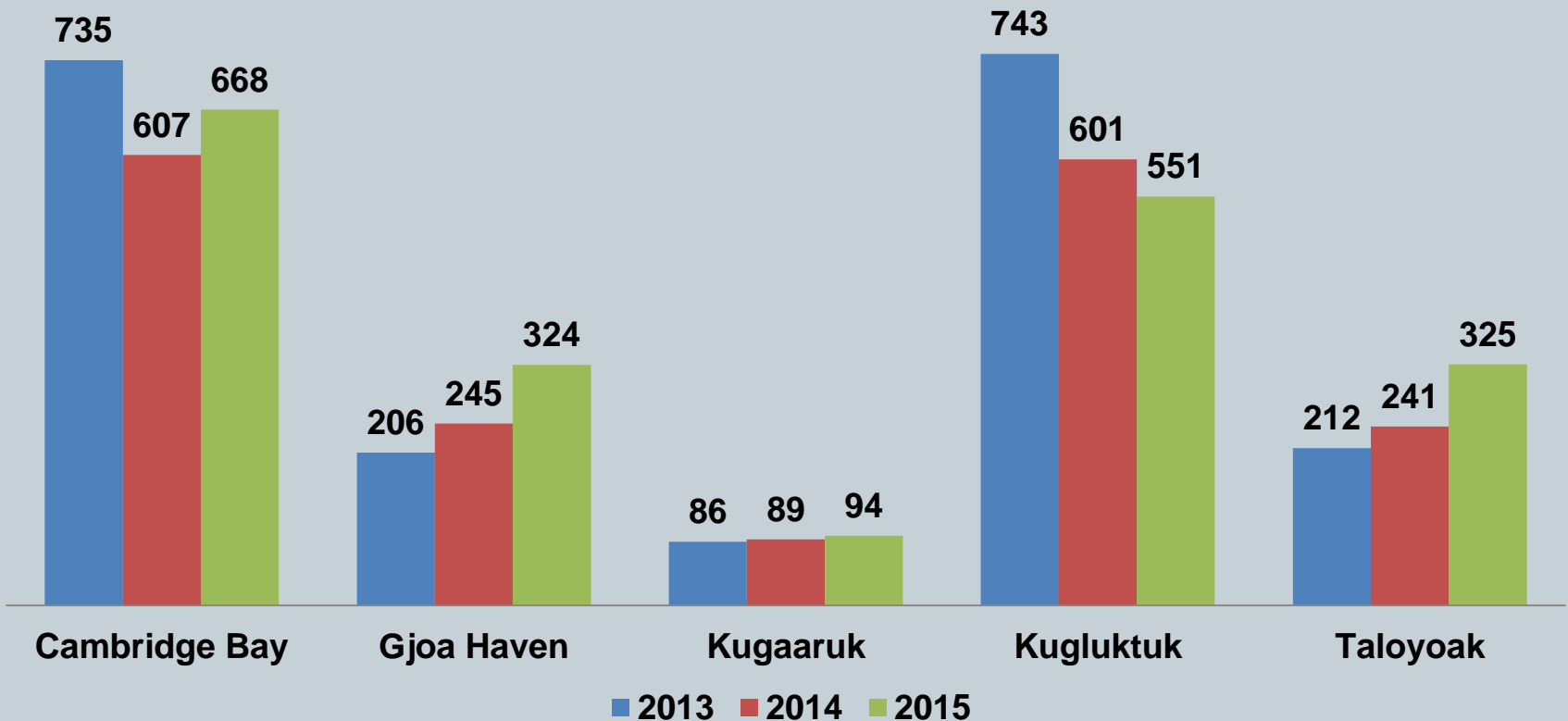

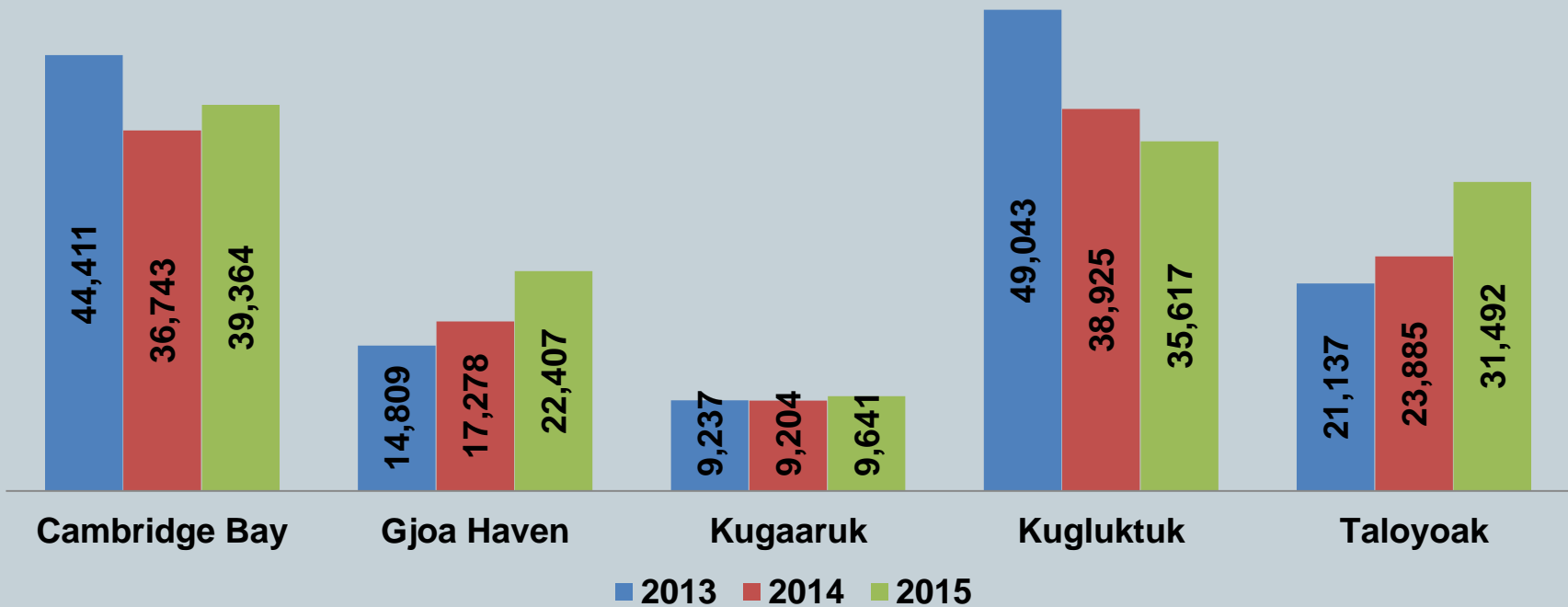
Criminal Violations 2013-2015

Criminal Violations per 100,000 Persons 2013-2015



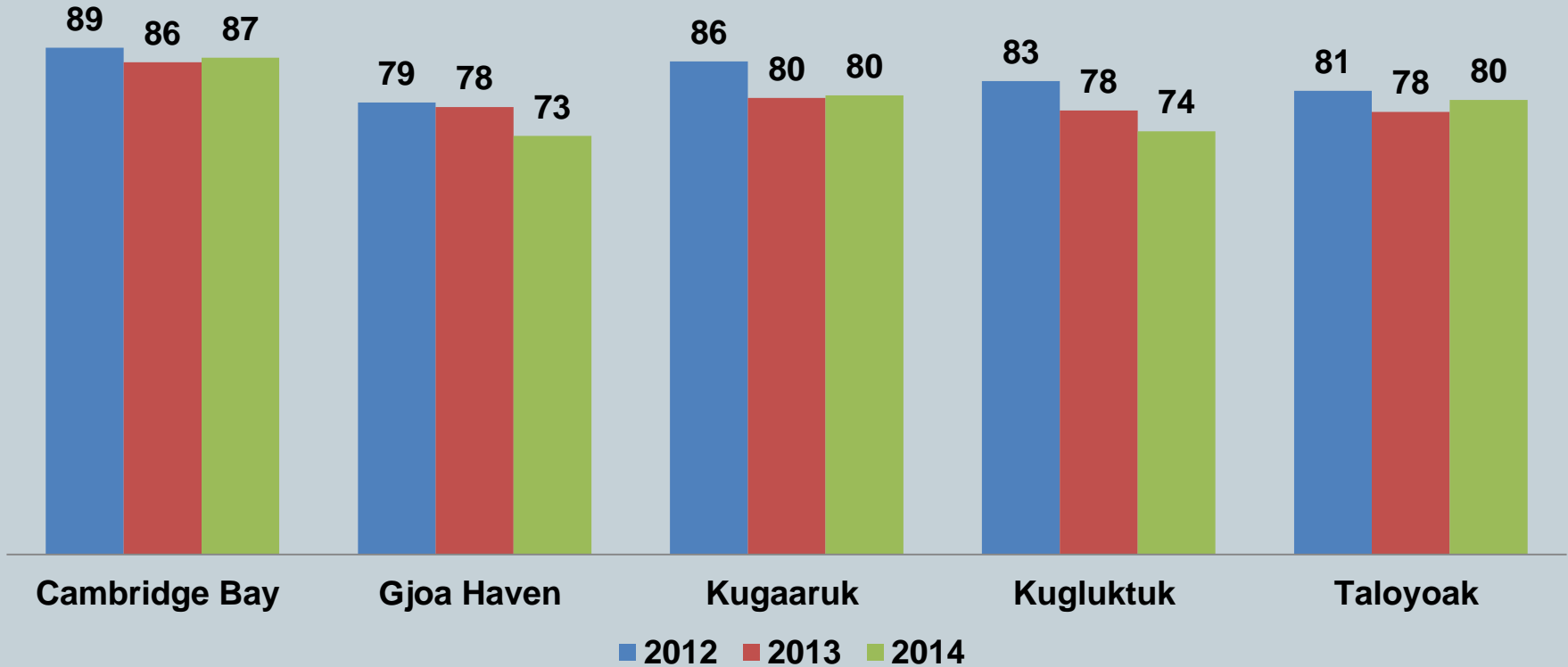

Proportion (%) of Taxfilers with Employment Income 2012 - 2014



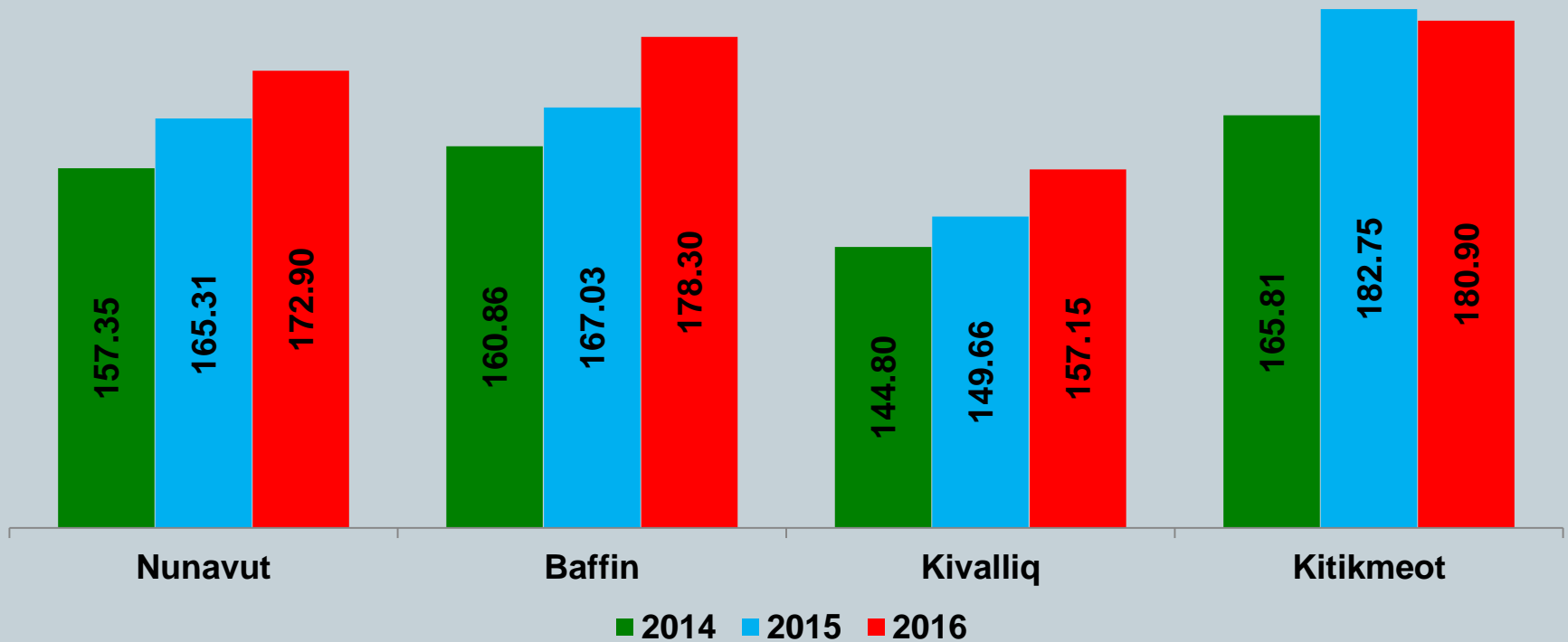

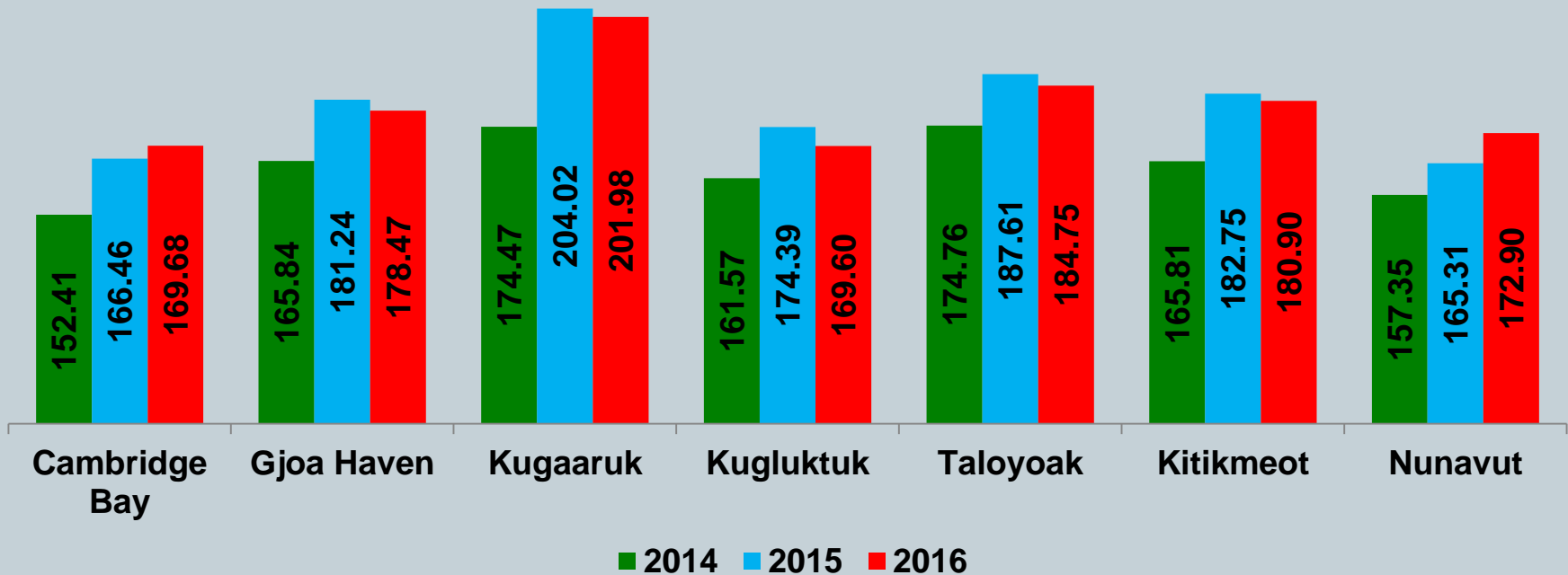
Average Cost (\$) of 24 Select Food Items

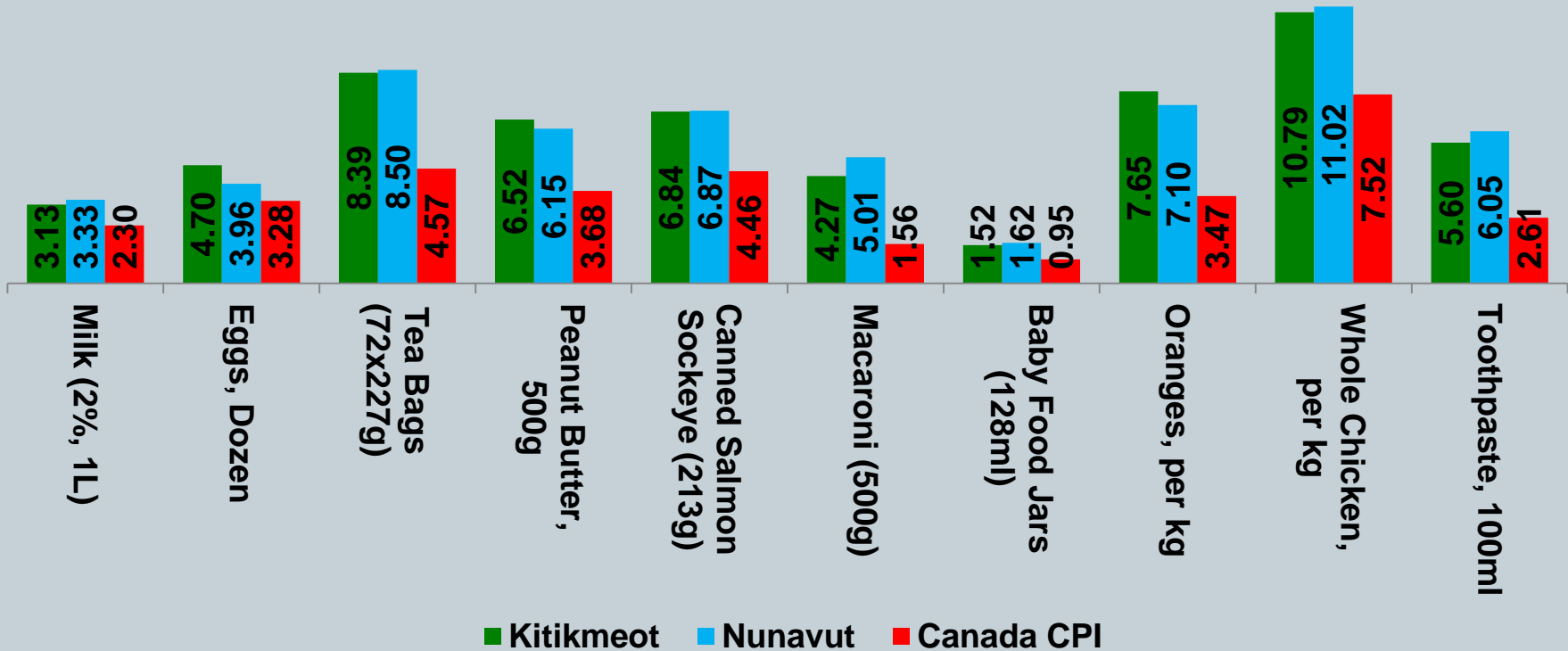




Nunavut Food Price Survey
